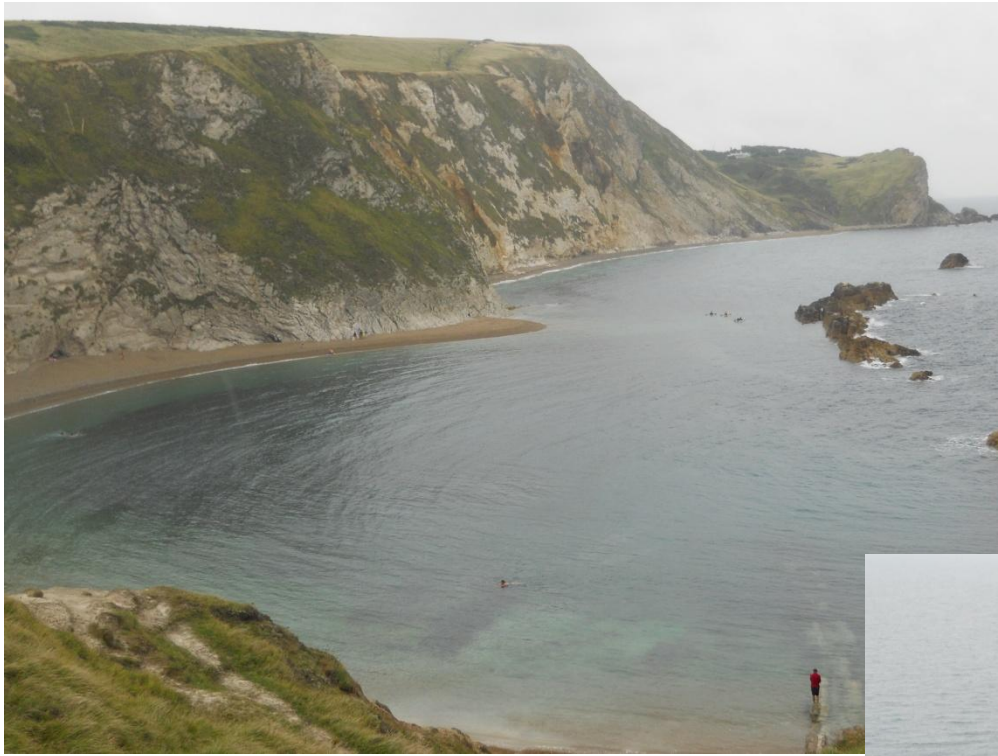

Corf castle

- In 2006, Corfe Castle was the National Trust's tenth most-visited historic house with 173,829 visitors
- The castle dates back to the 11th century, and commands a gap in the Purbeck Hills on the route between Wareham and Swanage



Swanage

- originally a small port and fishing village flourished in the Victorian era
- today the town remains a popular tourist resort
